A NOTE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



2017 was a remarkable year! We made progress on several goals we set out to accomplish at the beginning of 2017. In August we opened a prenatal clinic to provide care, test and medication to pregnant women. We also started a trial operation of distributing water kits for clean water. In partnership with the local non-profit organization, Water With Blessings, we distributed water filters and provided training to local individuals.



PRENATAL CLINIC OPENS

After a year of planning and effort, we opened our first prenatal clinic in October 2017, where we provide regular check-ups, distribute prenatal vitamins and other medications, and educate women about healthy pregnancy and safe delivery.

Our onsite staff Nurse Lamour (pictured on the left) is managing the clinic.

TRAINING


We provided training to the local hospital on 'Helping Babies Breathe' which reduces infant mortality in the first days of life. Over a three-month period, the hospital staff was able to save the lives of 6 out of 11 premature infants that were delivered at the hospital.



FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS



2017 Spending



Through the generous contributions from many of our patrons, we raised close to \$30,000 in contributions from our annual fundraisers and generous donations from our supporters. Most of the donations we received were spent on our annual Medical Clinic Fair and starting our Prenatal program.

Since we are a volunteer organization, very little, approximate 9%, was spent on Administrative expenses, where a significant portion of the expense was a one-time event related to Massachusetts registration fees, and the remaining was spent on website hosting, and other miscellaneous items.


Financial Goals

Our Board has agreed to a target of raising \$30,000 in 2018. This will allow us to continue the Prenatal Clinic operations and fund the Medical Clinic and Education programs.

2018 Medical Clinic Trip

In January 2018 we have a committed a group of 19 medical and non-medical volunteers who will travel to La Gonave to provide medical care, training, and public health education. We plan to:

- Conduct church-based medical clinics and remote clinics
- Provide health education to children on menstrual hygiene and clean water
- Collaborate with the local hospital to provide medical training and medical care
- Distribute water filters to churches, other institutions, and families
